government. Now I have decided to open my boutique for recognition my skills and to establish my own identity in society. I will inaugurate my boutique in current month.

In the month of October she got the certificate for successful completion of the courses under the project by Ms. Karuna Rai, Assistant commissioner, DIC, Varanasi.

I will introduce the boutique product in national and international market with support of Hunar-E-Banaras. I am ready to online and offline marketing of product. I will work for the respect, honor and livelihood of women and be the proud of Varanasi.
